The required core curriculum of the Master of Arts in Clinical Mental Health Counseling program meets the education requirements for licensure as a mental health counselor in the state of Florida.

The graduate counseling program can be completed on either a three-year full-time or four-year part-time plan, shown below. An alternative five-year program of study is available with faculty approval for students who need to spread the 1000-hour clinical requirement over more terms.

Additional electives and certificate programs in Family & Relationship Counseling and College & University Counseling are also available to currently enrolled degree-seeking students.

Courses must be taken in the assigned sequence shown on the following page. Students desiring to change from the full-time to part-time program or add a certificate track should contact the Interim Director of Student Services for an advising appointment.
